"TENTATIVE" SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES

Early Registration: Begins at 3p on Tuesday, May 29, 2012.

National Automobile Museum: Home to the "Harrah Collection," one of the most comprehensive public displays of automobiles in the Western Hemisphere. Houses an extensive collection of automobiles, memorabilia, art collections and vintage clothing, theatre presentations, audio tours and a Museum store.

Tours of "Personal" Collections: Visit the Ted Bacon Minden Automotive Museum, consisting of approximately 80 cars ranging from 1911 to the 1930s. Lunch stop at Bill and Dorine Ramsden's car collection and museum. And, enjoy a tour of Mike and Sharon Silvera's collection, which houses many of the artifacts from the old Ponderosa Ranch theme park which operated from 1967 to 2004 in Incline Village, NV.

V&T Railroad/Historic Virginia City: Travel back through history over the original Virginia & Truckee (V&T) Railroad line between Carson City and Virginia City. Spend the day in historic Virginia City, the "richest place on earth" during the gold and silver mining boom between 1860 and 1880. Today, it's the largest National Historic Monument in the U.S. Tour mansions, museums and mines, eat and drink in Old West saloons, shopping, etc.

Rappin' To Minden: Join the "Northern Nevada Chapter" at their annual "Rappin' To Minden" Inliner event in downtown Minden, NV in conjunction with the Minden Spring Festival.
